Baldwin began an oral history project with his late father-in-law, John Hanson Briscoe, with discussions on his life in St. Mary's County before the base, his political and legal career, and Sotterley. While conducting research, he saw a single sentence footnote in an old book that claimed Governor Plater was buried "under a cherry tree" at Sotterley. Baldwin's curiosity was set on finding the truth about the gravesite. Despite facing criticism, a ground penetrating radar confirmed the likely existence of a crypt, as Baldwin predicted!
